-To God Be the Glory (Part III)

-Ephesians 3:1-6 (LSB) 1 For this reason I, Paul, the prisoner of Christ Jesus on behalf of you Gentiles-- 2 if indeed you heard of the stewardship of God's grace which was given to me for you; 3 that by revelation there was made known to me the mystery, as I wrote before in brief. 4 About which, when you read you can understand my insight into the mystery of Christ, 5 which in other generations was not made known to the sons of men, as it was now revealed to His holy apostles and prophets in the Spirit: 6 that the Gentiles are fellow heirs and fellow members of the body, and fellow partakers of the promise in Christ Jesus through the gospel,

-Luke 6:46 (LSB) “Now why do you call Me, ‘Lord, Lord,’ and do not do what I say?”

-Romans 4:3 (LSB) For what does the Scripture say? “ABRAHAM BELIEVED GOD, AND IT WAS COUNTED TO HIM AS RIGHTEOUSNESS.”

**-Thus/So/In the same manner also
these now have been disobedient
because of the mercy shown to you
in order that/for the purpose that
they also now might be shown
mercy.**

-Romans 3:9-12 (LSB) 9 What then? Are we better? Not at all; for we have already charged that both Jews and Greeks are all under sin; 10 as it is written, "THERE IS NONE RIGHTEOUS, NOT EVEN ONE; 11 THERE IS NONE WHO UNDERSTANDS, THERE IS NONE WHO SEEKS FOR GOD; 12 ALL HAVE TURNED ASIDE, TOGETHER THEY HAVE BECOME WORTHLESS; THERE IS NONE WHO DOES GOOD, THERE IS NOT EVEN ONE."

-...19 Now we know that whatever the Law says, it speaks to those who are in the Law, so that every mouth may be shut and all the world may become accountable to God; 20 because by the works of the Law NO FLESH WILL BE JUSTIFIED IN HIS SIGHT, for through the Law comes the knowledge of sin. 21 But now apart from the Law the righteousness of God has been manifested, being witnessed by the Law and the Prophets, 22 even the righteousness of God through faith in Jesus Christ for all those who believe; for there is no distinction; 23 for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, 24 being justified as a gift by His grace through the redemption which is in Christ Jesus;

-Romans 9:18-21 (LSB) 18 So then He has mercy on whom He desires, and He hardens whom He desires. 19 You will say to me then, “Why does He still find fault? For who resists His will?” 20 On the contrary, who are you, O man, who answers back to God? WILL THE THING MOLDED SAY TO THE MOLDER, “WHY DID YOU MAKE ME LIKE THIS”? 21 Or does not the potter have authority over the clay, to make from the same lump one vessel for honorable use and another for dishonorable use?

**-Psalms 77:19 (LSB) Your way was
in the sea And Your paths in the
mighty waters, But Your footprints
were not known.**

-Psalms 139:1-6 (LSB) 1 For the choir director. Of David. A Psalm. O Yahweh, You have searched me and known me. 2 You know when I sit down and when I rise up; You understand my thought from afar. 3 You scrutinize my path and my lying down, And are intimately acquainted with all my ways. 4 Even before there is a word on my tongue, Behold, O Yahweh, You know it all. 5 You have enclosed me behind and before, And You have put Your hand upon me. 6 Such knowledge is too wonderful for me; It is too high, I cannot attain to it.

encompassed the Spirit of Yahweh,
Or as His counselor has informed
Him?**

**-Job 41:11 (LSB) “Who has given to
Me that I should repay him?
Whatever is under the whole
heaven is Mine.**

-1 Timothy 1:12-17 (LSB) 12 *I am grateful to Christ Jesus our Lord*, who has strengthened me, because He regarded me faithful, putting me into service, 13 even though I was formerly a blasphemer and a persecutor and a violent aggressor. Yet *I was shown mercy* because I acted ignorantly in unbelief; 14 and *the grace of our Lord was more than abundant*, with the faith and love which are in Christ Jesus. 15 It is a trustworthy saying and deserving full acceptance: that *Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners, among whom I am foremost*. 16 Yet for this reason I was shown mercy, so that in me as the foremost, Christ Jesus might demonstrate all His patience as an example for those who are going to believe upon Him for eternal life. 17 *Now to the King of the ages, immortal, invisible, the only God, be honor and glory forever and ever. Amen.*
