- I. The Importance of the Book
 - A. In traditional Jewish culture, Leviticus is the first book a child usually would learn
 - B. There is a high usage of the book in the New Testament
- II. Classic Themes and Perspectives On Leviticus
 - A. Leviticus is often broken down into a two-part division
 - B. Key concepts
 - 1. How to enter into God's presence for worship
 - 2. How to be pure before a Holy God
 - 3. Barriers between us and God because of sin
 - 4. How to be forgiven
 - 5. How to live reconciled with our neighbor
- III. A Christological Approach
 - A. Luke 24:27, 44 and Hebrews 1:1-2
 - B. The Law, the Writings, and the Prophets find their fulfillment in Jesus
 - C. Five key concepts, revisited
 - D. If the Old Testament is type and shadow of the one to come, and Christ is the fulfillment of the Law and all the covenants, then we should be able to see him in the text of Leviticus
