**Elihu's Speech, part 2**  
**Job 34:1-35:16**

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**1. Elihu's second and third speech.**

**34:1-15.** Elihu quotes Job and then chides Job and his friends for their \_\_\_\_\_ views of God.

**34:16-20.** Elihu specifically rebukes Job and defends God's \_\_\_\_\_.

**34:21-37.** Elihu reminds Job that God is Judge and He sees \_\_\_\_\_ things; no one's life is hidden from Him.
