**Matthew 22:34-40** <sup>34</sup> But when the Pharisees heard that he had silenced the Sadducees, they gathered together. <sup>35</sup> And one of them, a lawyer, asked him a question to test him. <sup>36</sup> "Teacher, which is the great commandment in the Law?" <sup>37</sup> And he said to him, "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind. <sup>38</sup> This is the great and first commandment. <sup>39</sup> And a second is like it: You shall love your neighbor as yourself. <sup>40</sup> On these two commandments depend all the Law and the Prophets."

## **5. Love Is Not Arrogant**

**1 Corinthians 8:1** Knowledge puffs up, but love edifies.  
**Matthew 18:4** Therefore whoever humbles himself as this little child is the greatest in the kingdom of heaven.  
**Luke 14:10** But when you are invited, go and sit down in the lowest place, so that when he who invited you comes he may say to you, 'Friend, go up higher.' Then you will have glory in the presence of those who sit at the table with you.  
**Luke 22:26** he who is greatest among you, let him be as the younger, and he who governs as he who serves.  
**1 Peter 5:5** Likewise you younger people, submit yourselves to *your* elders. Yes, all of *you* be submissive to one another, and be clothed with humility, for "*God resists the proud, But gives grace to the humble.*"

## **6. Love Does Not Behave Rudely**

**Philippians 1:10** that you may approve the things that are excellent, that you may be sincere and without offense till the day of Christ,  
**2 Thessalonians 3:7** For you yourselves know how you ought to follow us, for we were not disorderly among you;

## **7. Love Is Not Selfish**

**1 Corinthians 10:24** Let no one seek his own, but each one the other's *well-being*.  
**Philippians 2:4** Let each of you look out not only for his own interests, but also for the interests of others.

## **8. Love Is Not Irritable**

**Romans 12:18** If it is possible, as much as depends on you, live peaceably with all men.  
**Colossians 3:8** But now you yourselves are to put off all these: anger, wrath, malice, blasphemy, filthy language out of your mouth.  
**James 1:19** So then, my beloved brethren, let every man be swift to hear, slow to speak, slow to wrath;  
**Psalms 37:8** Cease from anger, and forsake wrath; Do not fret--*it only causes harm.*  
**Proverbs 16:32** *He who is slow to anger is better than the mighty, And he who rules his spirit than he who takes a city.*  
**Proverbs 19:11** The discretion of a man makes him slow to anger, And his glory *is* to overlook a transgression.  
**Ecclesiastes 7:9** Do not hasten in your spirit to be angry, For anger rests in the bosom of fools.

## **9. Love Is Not Resentful**

**Matthew 5:39** But I tell you not to resist an evil person. But whoever slaps you on your right cheek, turn the other to him also.  
**Romans 12:17** Repay no one evil for evil. Have regard for good things in the sight of all men.  
**1 Thessalonians 5:15** See that no one renders evil for evil to anyone, but always pursue what is good both for yourselves and for all.  
**1 Peter 3:9** not returning evil for evil or reviling for reviling, but on the contrary blessing, knowing that you were called to this, that you may inherit a blessing.

## **10. Love Does Not Rejoice In Wrong Doing**

**Matthew 7:3** And why do you look at the speck in your brother's eye, but do not consider the plank in your own eye?  
**Romans 15:1** We then who are strong ought to bear with the scruples of the weak, and not to please ourselves.
