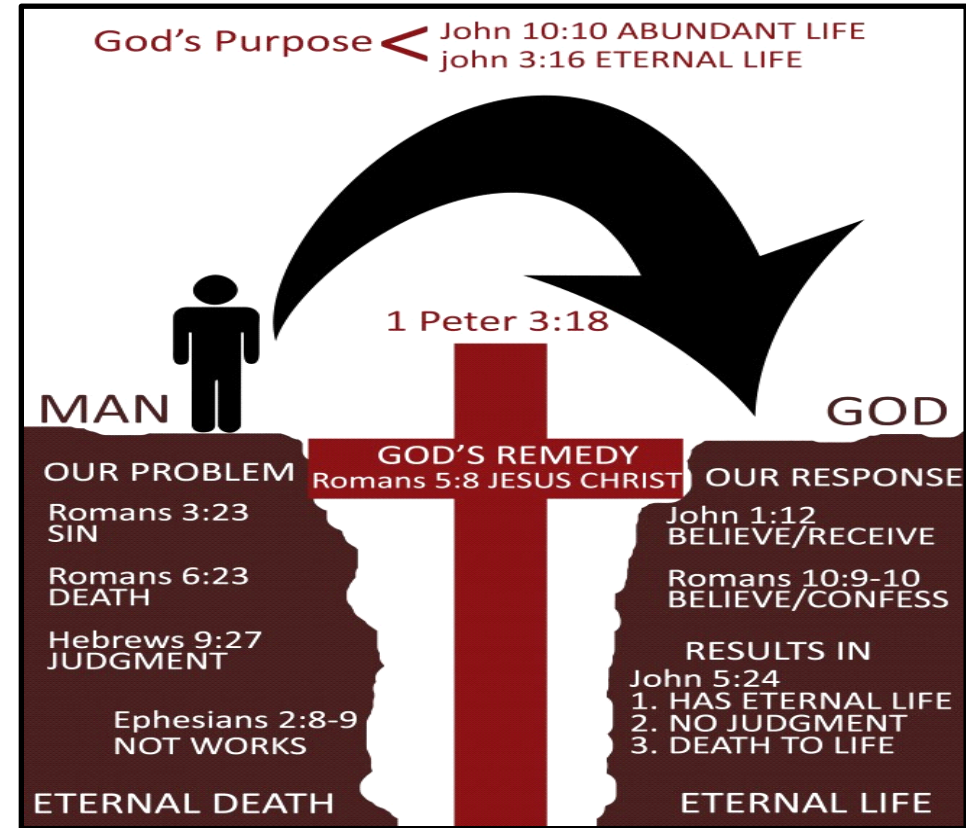

Be Ready
Luke 12:35–48

We must be ready for the Lord's imminent return!

v. 35 - Be like servants who are fully prepared to serve their master.

v. 36 - Be like servants waiting eagerly and enthusiastically for their master's return.

v. 37 - Be like servants who are confident of their master's reward!

v. 38 - Be like servants that are ready for their master to come home at anytime!

v. 39–40 - Jesus said His second coming would be imminent.

- The one who does not plan for the Lord's coming will lose everything.
- Believers must be ready at any moment.

v. 41 - Peter asks if all people should be ready or just the disciples.

v. 42–48 - Jesus answers with another parable about servants.

v. 42–44 - A faithful and wise servant will be rewarded.

- The apostles were stewards in God's household (1Co 4:1–2).
- Pastors are stewards (Titus 1:7).
- All believers are stewards in God's household - **1 Peter 4:10**
- The Lord rewards His faithful stewards with greater participation and responsibility (Mat 19:28; 1Pe 5:4; Luk 19:16–19; Rev 5:10; 1Co 6:3).

v. 45–48 - Unfaithful and unwise servants will be punished.

v. 45–46 - Wicked servants will be cast out of God's household.

- False apostles (John 17:12)
- False pastors (Acts 20:29–30)
- False believers (Philippians 3:18–19)

v. 47 - Disobedient servants will be punished.

v. 48a - Ignorant servants will not be excused.

v. 48b - The Lord will judge each believer for his stewardship - **2 Corinthians 5:10 For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ, that each one may receive the things done in the body, according to what he has done, whether good or bad.**

Believers who are enthusiastically watching and serving will be ready - **2 Timothy 4:8 Finally, there is laid up for me the crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous Judge, will give to me on that Day, and not to me only but also to all who have loved His appearing.**
