

Put on The Lord Jesus Christ
Romans 13:13–14

Knowing the time, that our salvation is nearer than when we first believed!

It's time to wake up, the day is at hand!

It's time to cast off the works of darkness and arm ourselves with the armor of light!

Let us walk properly, as in the day, not in revelry and drunkenness, not in lewdness and lust, not in strife and envy.

- The Christian walk began the day we got saved - **John 8:12 Then Jesus spoke to them again, saying, "I am the light of the world. He who follows Me shall not walk in darkness, but have the light of life.**
- The Christian walk continues steadily and progressively - **Romans 6:4**
- The Christian walk has a destination - **2 Corinthians 5:6–8**
- Our conduct ought to be appropriate for a Christian - **1 Thessalonians 4:12 that you may walk properly toward those who are outside; Colossians 4:5 Walk in wisdom toward those who are outside, redeeming the time; 1 Peter 2:11–12 Beloved, I beg you as sojourners and pilgrims, abstain from fleshly lusts which war against the soul, having your conduct honorable among the Gentiles, that when they speak against you as evildoers, they may, by your good works which they observe, glorify God in the day of visitation.**
- We are to be walking in the way of the new life in Christ and not in the ways of this dark evil world - **Ephesians 5:8 For you were once darkness, but now you are light in the Lord. Walk as children of light**
- The truth is, this world is full of pleasure-seeking insatiable debauchery that will only destroy people and their relationships.
- Three pairs of wicked behaviors describe the character of the darkness of this evil age.
- Revelry and drunkenness describe worldly pleasures.
- Lewdness and lust describe selfish indulgences.
- Strife and envy describe broken unloving relationships.

But put on the Lord Jesus Christ, and make no provision for the flesh, to fulfill its lusts.

- To put on Christ is not an outward adherence to religious ceremonies.
- To put on Christ means to be more like Christ in His character, and following His example, and to be so identified with Him it's as if He's a garment you wear.
- We put on Christ through knowing His word and obeying His word.
- The flesh is the sin nature. It will never improve. It will always be corrupt.
- The flesh will always lust after what is selfish and always be contrary to God.
- We are not to preplan to indulge in our flesh.
- We must be making continuous efforts to arrange our thinking and our habits of life in order to remove any opportunities for the flesh to be indulged.

Are we living in such a way that it is obvious that we are serious about following Christ?

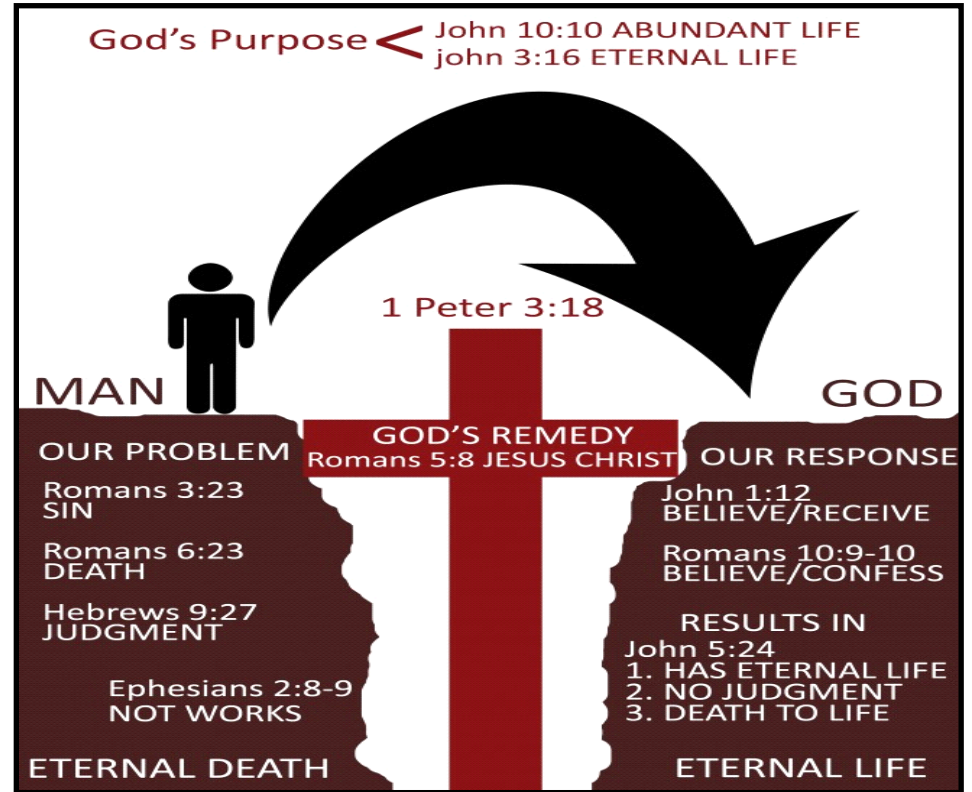
