 - b. bad: Lot and his daughters Judah Potiphar's wife Reuben -David & Bathsheba - Amnon - Proverbs 5-6 - Lev. 18 & numerous New Testament exhortations
 - 3. These Scriptures are to be part of our 'family worship teaching'
