

Therefore receive one another, just as Christ also received us, to the glory of God.

Now I say that Jesus Christ has become a servant to the circumcision for the truth of God, to confirm the promises made to the fathers,

- The Messiah who is exalted has become a servant Mark 10:45 For even the Son of Man did
 not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life a ransom for many."
- He became a servant to the children of Abraham certify the truthfulness of God.
- He became a servant to the unfaithful nation of Israel to fulfill for them the covenants and promises God made to their forefathers.

and that the Gentiles might glorify God for His mercy,

An expanded purpose for Christ's ministry to the undeserving Jews is so that unworthy Gentiles might glorify God for His mercy toward them - Galatians 3:8 And the Scripture, foreseeing that God would justify the Gentiles by faith, preached the gospel to Abraham beforehand, saying, "In you all the nations shall be blessed."

as it is written: "FOR THIS REASON I WILL CONFESS TO YOU AMONG THE GENTILES, AND SING TO YOUR NAME."

- Christ is confessing God among the Gentiles Psalm 18:49; Galatians 3:16 Now to Abraham
 and his Seed were the promises made. He does not say, "And to seeds," as of many, but as
 of one, "AND TO YOUR SEED," who is Christ.
- Christ is confessing God among the Gentiles through Christians Ephesians 2:17; 2
 Corinthians 5:20 Now then, we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God were pleading through us: we implore you on Christ's behalf, be reconciled to God.

And again he says: "REJOICE, O GENTILES, WITH HIS PEOPLE!"

 Gentiles rejoicing with Israel over God's righteous judgments in His dealings with the nation of Israel - Deuteronomy 32:43; 1 John 2:2 And He Himself is the propitiation for our sins, and not for ours only but also for the whole world.

And again: "PRAISE THE LORD, ALL YOU GENTILES! LAUD HIM, ALL YOU PEOPLES!"

All Gentiles are to join in praise for the Lord's merciful loving-kindness - Psalm 117; John
 3:16 For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.

And again, Isaiah says: "THERE SHALL BE A ROOT OF JESSE; AND HE WHO SHALL RISE TO REIGN OVER THE GENTILES, IN HIM THE GENTILES SHALL HOPE."

- When Christ returns, He will rule over every nation Isaiah 11:10; Matthew 15:27
- Today, you and I may enter His kingdom if we will confess Jesus is Lord Romans 10:12–13
 For there is no distinction between Jew and Greek, for the same Lord over all is rich to all who call upon Him. For "WHOEVER CALLS ON THE NAME OF THE LORD SHALL BE SAVED."

The ultimate purpose for Christ's ministry is that Jews and Gentiles together glorify God!
