God Has a Reason Romans 9:22–24

Not every descendant of Abraham is saved, but only those whom God has chosen.

The first objection to God's election accuses God of unrighteousness.

God is right to save whom He chooses because He is not obligated to save any sinner.

God is right to harden whom He chooses because He is not obligated to save any sinner.

The second objection to God's election accuses God of injustice.

It is illegitimate to question God because He has the free right to do what He wishes.

The last of four questions answering the second objection explains God's reason *He has mercy on whom He wills, and whom He wills He hardens (18).*

What if God, wanting to show His wrath and to make His power known, endured with much longsuffering the vessels of wrath prepared for destruction,

- What if God... What would you say to that? Back talk or humble acceptance?
- The *vessels of wrath* are not created for wrath. The grammar does not support double election or double predestination.
- The vessels of wrath are set for destruction Romans 2:4–5
- The point is not how they became vessels of wrath, but that destruction is meted
 out to the vessels of wrath because it suits them. They are vessels of wrath, so it's
 right to destroy them.
- God's will, directed by His holy character, necessitates His wrath upon sinners.
- God's holy wrath must be executed through His power over evil Romans 9:17
- God is very patient in restraining Himself not to immediately destroy the wicked, because He wants to show His wrath and make His power known over evil in a way that only He can - Exodus 15:1–21

and that He might make known the riches of His glory on the vessels of mercy, which He had prepared beforehand for glory,

- What if God has endured with much longsuffering the vessels of wrath prepared for destruction in order to make known the riches of his glory on the vessels of mercy. There is a divine contrast between wrath and mercy.
- God has beforehand made ready the vessels of mercy Acts 15:14 Simon has
 declared how God at the first visited the Gentiles to take out of them a people for His
 name.

even us whom He called, not of the Jews only, but also of the Gentiles?

- God effectually calls those whom he has chosen.
- God is calling out of both the Jews and the Gentiles a new people in Christ 1
 Peter 2:9–10 But you are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, His own
 special people, that you may proclaim the praises of Him who called you out of darkness
 into His marvelous light; who once were not a people but are now the people of God, who
 had not obtained mercy but now have obtained mercy.

God has the right to harden and show mercy upon whomever He chooses. God's reason for hardening Israel is because He wants to show mercy upon the Gentiles.


