

Jesus: Our Grain Offering
Leviticus 2:1-16

- I. The Presentation of the Grain Offering
 - A. This (along with the drink offering) is a bloodless offering
 - B. The key elements regarding the grain offering
- II. Some Nuances Regarding This Offering
 - A. Language – not the same word used in Leviticus 2:1 as was used in Leviticus 1:2
 - B. The word translated “grain offering” is only translated as such based-on context
- III. Jesus As Our Grain Offering
 - A. The metaphor of Jesus and bread is too abundant to miss
 - B. The offering is one of peace, honor, and fellowship
 - C. Seasoned with salt & a covenant of salt (2:13)
 - 1. Seasoned with salt
 - 2. Salt of the covenant
 - D. Bringing it all together
 - 1. God made a “covenant of salt” with the people
 - 2. In 1 Samuel 21, David eats the sacred bread, the bread promised to the priests – and he gave it to the men with him to eat
 - 3. Jesus is our covenant of salt and our grain offering.
