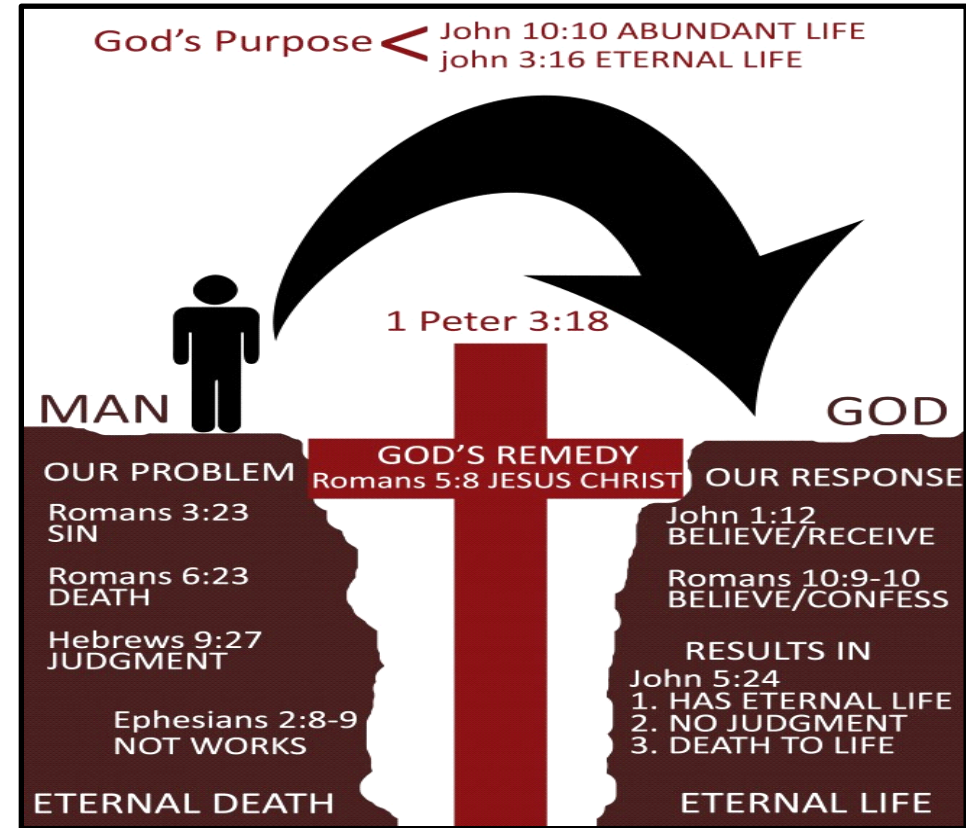

**David Spares Nabal
1 Samuel 25:1–44**

v. 1 - The death of Samuel left Israel without a man of God in leadership of the nation.

v. 2–3 - Nabal is introduced as a contrast to his wife Abigail.

v. 4–11 - David is presented as a contrast to Nabal.

- David could have taken what he needed but he showed respect in asking.
- Nabal had no respect for David - **1 Samuel 15:12**

v. 12–23 Abigail is contrasted to David.

- David was acting in his own power for his own vengeance (13).
- Abigail was acting wisely on behalf of her husband, household, and the Lord.

v. 24–31 - Abigail pleaded with David.

v. 32–35 - Abigail prevented David from the sin of taking his own personal vengeance (28).

v. 36–39a - The Lord struck down Nabal for making himself an enemy of David.

v. 39b–44 - David takes Abigail as wife.

Nabal was a foolish man.

- Nabal loved the world more than God - **1 John 2:15 Love not the world, neither the things that are in the world. If any man love the world, the love of the Father is not in him.**
- Nabal chose to make David his enemy.
- Nabal suffered the consequences of his sin.

Abigail was a wise woman.

- She believed God's word which promised David to be the Lord's anointed (30).
- She put her life at the mercy of David (28).
- She interceded for others (31).

David was protected by God's grace.

- The Lord again kept David from sin (26).
- The Lord showed David that He would vindicate him and destroy his enemies.
- The Lord gave grace to David, a flawed man - **Deuteronomy 17:17 Neither shall he multiply wives to himself, that his heart turn not away:**

Jesus, the greater Son of David, is without flaw, fault, weakness, or sin - **Hebrews 4:15 For we do not have a High Priest who cannot sympathize with our weaknesses, but was in all points tempted as we are, yet without sin.**
