MISSIONARY UPDATE

THE HUNTERS SOUTH AFRICA



March 12, 2024

(Excerpts from their recent letter.)

Many of you will remember that I have been talking about the team from my sending church in Saint John, New Brunswick that was going to send their youth group to visit us in South Africa. Well, they're here! We travelled to Cape Town on Thursday to collect them from the airport. They all made it safely with their luggage intact. We stayed Thursday night and Friday night at the Paardeberg Mountain Retreat near Paarl. My thought was that the teens could get a chance to see another camp facilities, even if the camp was somewhat quiet because it's off season at the moment.

On Saturday we made the 6.5 hour trip to Knysna complete with a luggage trailer in tow. Pastor Henderson, another adult sponsor and 7 of the teens ministered in the Word and in music on Sunday at our church. They were well received and did an excellent job at church. We enjoyed having them. We sent the other half of the group to My Father's House in Bonging, so they could enjoy a "township church" experience. This Sunday we'll swap places for the group.

Monday the teens came to our Knysna Hope meeting, and later that day, some of the teens served at a local soup kitchen, which they seemed to enjoy immensely. Meanwhile, the reminder of the group toured the township with me, getting a sense of some of what that is like.

Tuesday the boys took in the Iron Man Bible Study and the girls went to Fraaisig primary school to minister there. We traveled through to George to learn about Inspire George and the Foundation Theological Institute and the work God is doing there.

So far, it has been a privilege having these teens with us. They are respectful, willing to help and just a lot of fun to be around. Kind of makes me feel young again!

Pray for God to use this experience in their hearts...The fields are white but laborers are needed.
