- I. A Moral Community (13-14)
 - A. An aggressive charge
 - 1. In the presence of...
 - a. God - Giver of life to all
 - b. Jesus Christ – confessor before Pontius Pilate
 - 2. Setting the foundation for sovereign authority
 - B. Keep the commandment – what is it?
 - 1. All of the Mosaic Law – not likely
 - 2. The summation of the Law (love God, love people – perhaps)
 - 3. The gospel in general – very likely
 - C. How – in purity, both personally and publicly
 - D. For how long – until the final end of all things
- II. A Hopeful Community (14-16)
 - A. We are looking for the Second Coming of Jesus and the final culmination of all things
 - B. What should such hope produce in us? – Overwhelming praise!
 - 1. Blessed and Only Sovereign
 - 2. King of kings
 - 3. Lord of lords
 - 4. Only true possessor of immortality
 - 5. Dwelling in inapproachable light
 - 6. Whom no man has seen or can see
 - 7. Honor and eternal dominion
