II. AN OBSERVATION OF TODAY'S PARTICULARS

vv24-26, Faith that Exalts Christ

A. Background of Text

Exodus 2:11-14

- 1. Moses went out to his people
 - a. Moses sees Israel's affliction, v11
 - b. Moses secretly kills an Egyptian, v12
 - c. Moses seeks to settle a disputation, v13
 - d. Moses startled by his exposed indiscretion, v14

B. Breakdown of Text

- a. refused, faith rejects the titles of the world, v24 (Phil 2:7)
- b. choosing, faith shares in Christ's sufferings, v25 (Phil 3:10)
- c. considered, faith values Christ above all, v26 (Phil 3:8-9)

III. AN OCCASION FOR CELEBRATION BY THESE TRUTHS

- **A. faith** renounces worldly roles for humble & eternal ones (Jas 4:10)
- ${f B.\ faith\ rejoices\ that\ suffering\ makes\ us\ more\ like\ Christ\ (Jas\ 1:2-3)}$
- **C. faith** rightly esteems Christ as the Treasure of treasures (Jas 2:5)
- **D. faith** reigns within the soul of Christ's elect despite our often fleshly misgivings, misunderstandings, & misapplication (Ex 2:11-14)
