II. AN OBSERVATION OF TODAY'S PARTICULARS

vv24-26, **Faith that Exalts Christ**

A. Background of Text

Exodus 2:11-14

1. Moses *went out to his people*

a. Moses sees Israel's affliction, v11

b. Moses secretly kills an Egyptian, v12

c. Moses seeks to settle a disputation, v13

d. Moses startled by his exposed indiscretion, v14

B. Breakdown of Text

a. *refused*, faith rejects the titles of the world, v24 (Phil 2:7)

b. *choosing*, faith shares in Christ's sufferings, v25 (Phil 3:10)

c. *considered*, faith values Christ above all, v26 (Phil 3:8-9)

III. AN OCCASION FOR CELEBRATION BY THESE TRUTHS

A. **faith** renounces worldly roles for humble & eternal ones (Jas 4:10)

B. **faith** rejoices that suffering makes us more like Christ (Jas 1:2-3)

C. **faith** rightly esteems Christ as the Treasure of treasures (Jas 2:5)

D. **faith** reigns within the soul of Christ's elect despite our often fleshly misgivings, misunderstandings, & misapplication (Ex 2:11-14)
