

**Accountable for Unbelief**  
**Romans 10:14–21**

*How then shall they call on Him in whom they have not believed? And how shall they believe in Him of whom they have not heard? And how shall they hear without a preacher? And how shall they preach unless they are sent?*

- God is sovereign in salvation but He also holds men responsible through means.
- Five steps are given for the gospel's condition for salvation.
- Calling of the name of the LORD is expressing your faith in Christ.
- Believing into Christ is putting all your dependence into the person of Christ.
- Hearing is receiving and understanding the truth of Christ.
- Preaching is proclaiming Christ and the good news of salvation in Him!
- Sending is God commissioning sent ones to preach of the gospel of Christ.

*As it is written: "HOW BEAUTIFUL ARE THE FEET OF THOSE WHO PREACH THE GOSPEL OF PEACE, WHO BRING GLAD TIDINGS OF GOOD THINGS!"*

- God prophesied that Israel would fall into captivity in Babylon - **Isaiah 52:1–6**
- God promised to send the good news of salvation to Israel - **Isaiah 52:7–15**
- God has met the first two conditions for salvation: Sending and Preaching.

*But they have not all obeyed the gospel. For Isaiah says, "LORD, WHO HAS BELIEVED OUR REPORT?" - Israel has not obeyed the Lord's command to believe Christ - **Isaiah 53:1–12***

*So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God. But I say, have they not heard? Yes indeed: "THEIR SOUND HAS GONE OUT TO ALL THE EARTH, AND THEIR WORDS TO THE ENDS OF THE WORLD."*

- The word of God is the object and source of faith.
- Unbelief cannot be blamed upon God because everyone has heard.
- God has provided a clear understandable word that all have heard and all are accountable to and all will be judged by - **Psalms 19:4**
- The Lord sent the gospel to be proclaimed to everyone throughout the whole earth.

*But I say, did Israel not know? First Moses says: "I WILL PROVOKE YOU TO JEALOUSY BY THOSE WHO ARE NOT A NATION, I WILL MOVE YOU TO ANGER BY A FOOLISH NATION."*

- Moses gave prophecy of how Israel would scorn and forsake God and provoke Him to jealousy by giving themselves to other gods - **Deuteronomy 32:21**
- Moses foretold that Gentiles would receive the salvation Israel would reject.

*But Isaiah is very bold and says: "I WAS FOUND BY THOSE WHO DID NOT SEEK ME; I WAS MADE MANIFEST TO THOSE WHO DID NOT ASK FOR ME. But to Israel he says: "ALL DAY LONG I HAVE STRETCHED OUT MY HANDS TO A DISOBEDIENT AND CONTRARY PEOPLE."*

- God's judgment of Israel is so obviously deserving - **Isaiah 65:1–7**
- The prophecy has come true! God's salvation is so freely given that even the heathen are being saved! Which further magnifies the great inexcusable unbelief of Israel.

There is no excuse not to be saved: God has sent preachers to preach the gospel to all!

If you would like to give a special gift to this ministry this month, feel free to put it in the offering plate marked accordingly.

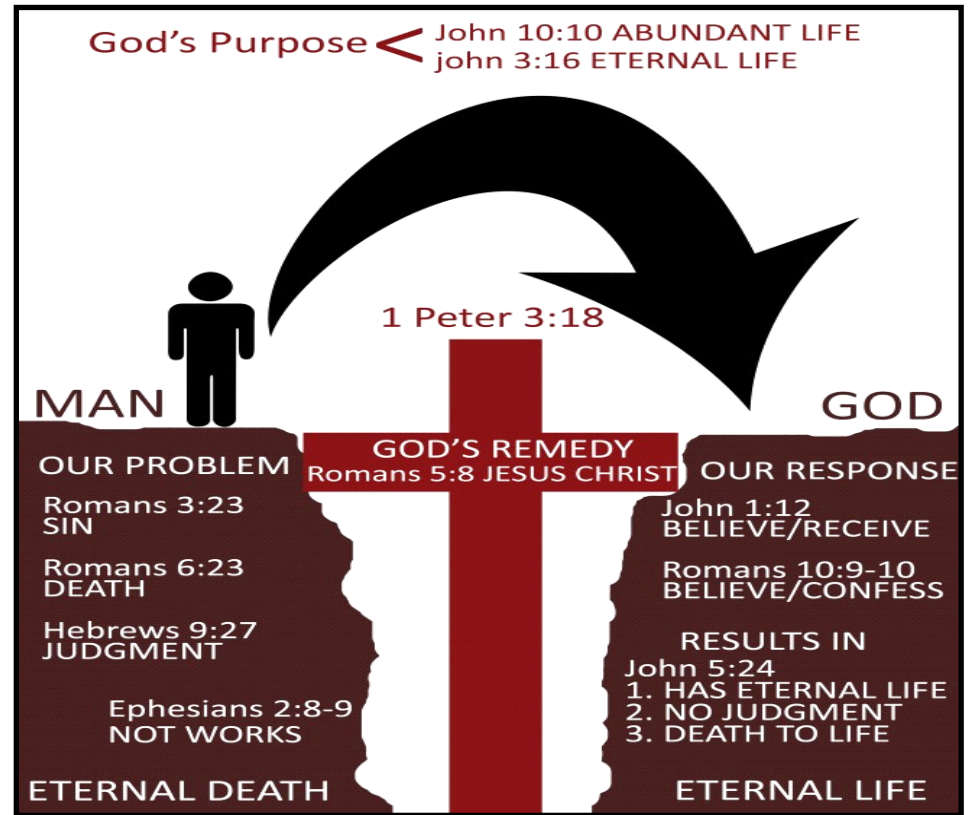
