

## DISTINGUISHING THE RESURRECTIONS OF THE BIBLE

### I. Distinguishing the different Resurrections not only **GENERALLY** but **SPECIFICALLY**

#### A. The **FACT** of Resurrection

1. The book of \_\_\_\_\_, which is also a book that deals with man very early in history. (Job 19:25-27)

d. Dead Millennium \_\_\_\_\_ at the end of Kingdom. (Isaiah 65:20)

\* Do people die during the Millennial phase of the Kingdom?
