

Jesus' Unjust Suffering



Luke 23:1-25

- 1) Jesus lived our life and died our death
 - a) Falsely accused & declared guilty by religious leaders (23:1-2, 5)
 - b) Affirmed innocent by the Romans (23:4, 14-16, 22)
 - c) Whipped, mocked, & beaten for being innocent (22:63-65; 23:11, 16)
 - d) Betrayed by His own people, demanding His crucifixion (23:23)
 - e) Selected to die in place of a murderer (23:25)
- 2) By His stripes believers are healed (Isa. 53:5)
 - a) His pain, our gain
 - b) Jesus declares believers righteous (Rom. 3:21-31)
 - c) You get no credit for being patient if you are beaten for doing wrong. But if you suffer for doing good and endure it patiently, God is pleased with you (1 Pet. 2:20, NLT).
- 3) Application: sharing sorrows with Christ
 - a) Don't miss an opportunity to believe, unlike Judas, Pilate, & Herod
 - b) Suffer as an evangelistic endeavor (27:14; cf. Phil. 1:12)
 - c) When falsely accused, remember Jesus' example to us
