Mark 3:13-19 — "Jesus' Choosing of the Twelve"

"A dozen men under the power of the Holy Spirit are a more potent force than the teeming masses whose initial enthusiasm for Jesus was apparently provoked by little more than sheer curiosity." (John MacArthur)

"The only thing that walks back from the tomb with the mourners and refuses to be buried is the character of a man. What a man is survives him. It can never be buried." (J.R. Miller)

Ministers of the Gospel [By application: all men of God] must be...

- They must BE IMITATORS OF CHRIST.
- They must BE LOVERS OF SOULS.
- They must BE ALERT AGAINST SATAN.
- They must BE VIGILANT IN PRAYER

Background to Mark 3.13-19

- And the main pivot/turning point of Mark's gospel is 3:20-30 = official rejection. Why? Mark is hurrying to get to his main purpose for writing, to show that Jesus is the *Suffering Servant* who came to give his life a ransom for many.
- 2 stories leading up to the main pivot/transitional passage:
 - 1) the exceeding popularity of Christ (Mark 3:7-12)
 - 2) the commissioned Apostles of Christ (Mark 3:13-19)

THESIS — Let's ascend the "Holy Mountain" with Jesus to learn about the Choosing of the 12 Apostles. I'll teach this in 3 applicational statements for you.

I. <u>VIGILANTLY PRAY!</u> The intercession for the 12 (13; Lk 6.12)

A. THEME: travail in prayer / vigilantly pray

- B. Jesus prayed: (Luke 6.12)
 - ♣ The time after much conflict/controversy
 - the place isolated on a mountain (alone)
 - ❖ The purpose to pray: to be seech his Father
 - ❖ The duration all night in prayer
 - ❖ The communion to God
 - The preparation selecting the 12; the sermon.

II. EMBRACE WEAKNESS! The identification of the 12 (16-19)

A. THEME: Triumph in weakness; embrace weakness

Mark 3:13-19 — "Jesus' Choosing of the Twelve"

Simple observations about the text:

- √ they are all men; no women.
- ✓ there are 12 (parallel to 12 tribes of Israel of Old Covenant; not replacing Israel, but a new era in God's redemptive plan)
- √ they have a laser-focused mission
- √ they all had to be with Christ & be sent by Christ
- √ they all were untrained, ordinary, common men. (least likely!)
- ✓ in their weakness, they have a praying Intercessor (Jesus!)

III. PROCLAIM CHRIST! The mission of the 12 (14-15)

A. THEME: Tell of Christ // Proclaim Christ

3 main purposes:

- 1. TO BE with Him (be a disciple) -
- 2. TO PREACH (to declare) -
- 3. TO CAST OUT demons (to deliver)

Simple take-aways for you:

- **✓ KNOW** the pastor's work.
- ✓ **GROW** commit to the Word & increasing in godliness.
- ✓ GO down to knees in prayer for your ministers, the Truth, the Church & evangelization.
- ✓ **SOW** serve & do work of ministry (Eph 4.12-13)
