Ecclesiastes 5:18-20

¹⁸ Here is what I have seen to be good and fitting: to eat, to drink and enjoy oneself in all one's labor in which he toils under the sun during the few years of his life which God has given him; for this is his reward. ¹⁹ Furthermore, as for every man to whom God has given riches and wealth, He has also empowered him to eat from them and to receive his reward and rejoice in his labor; this is the gift of God. ²⁰ For he will not often consider the years of his life, because God keeps him occupied with the gladness of his heart.

1. ACKNOWLEDGE OUR _____AS COMING FROM GOD (3:22)

- a. All that we have comes from the hand of God (2:24-25; 3:12-13; 5:19; cp. Jas. 1:17-18)
- b. We cannot enjoy anything without God (2:25)
- c. Even adversity comes from God (cp. Job 2:10; Rom. 8:28ff)

2. LEARN TO ENJOY IN THE PRESENT (3:22; 5:18-19; 8:15; 9:7-8)
a. Develop a proper attitude towards God's gifts (3:22; 5:18)
b. Enjoy what you do have (not what you do not have) (5:18-20)
c. Turn events in life into a time of joy (8:15; 9:7-8)
3. MAKE THE OF OUR LIFE (AS A GIFT THAT GOD HAS GIVEN US) (11:1-12:7)
a. Live with a purpose (11:1-8)
b. Maximize your life (11:9-12:7)
1. Understand the passages in life (9-10)
2. Avoid sinful behavior
3. Keep God in your life (12:1, 13-14)
