God's Greater Purpose through Israel Romans 11:11–22

God has judicially blinded Israel in the past (Isaiah 6:9–10; 29:10; **Deuteronomy 29:1–4**; **Psalm 69:22–23**) and is judicially blinding Israel now - *v. 7–10*

I say then, have they stumbled that they should fall? Certainly not! But through their fall, to provoke them to jealousy, salvation has come to the Gentiles.

- Israel's national failure to obtain salvation in Christ is not a final downfall.
- God has a divine purpose beyond human comprehension in all He does.
- Israel's failure opens up salvation for the Gentles.
- God's salvation of Gentiles is meant to cause Jews to consider God's work of salvation through Christ and repent - Romans 11:13–14

Now if their fall is riches for the world, and their failure riches for the Gentiles, how much more their fullness! For if their being cast away is the reconciling of the world, what will their acceptance be but life from the dead?

- Blessing to the world comes through Israel regardless of the condition of Israel because God promised the blessing unconditionally (Genesis 12:3).
- The judgment upon Israel is temporary.
- Israel has temporarily lost its place of national blessing.
- Israel's restoration means the resurrection from the dead and the restoration of all creation - Isaiah 2:1-5

For if the first fruit is holy, the lump is also holy; and if the root is holy, so are the branches. And if some of the branches were broken off, and you, being a wild olive tree, were grafted in among them, and with them became a partaker of the root and fatness of the olive tree,

- The "fathers" are the first fruit and the root Romans 11:28; 15:8
- The Holy Spirit uses a metaphor of an olive tree to teach us how to think about the current situation between the nation of Israel and Gentile Christians.
- The branches represent Israel. The wild olive tree represents Gentiles.
- The root is the place of blessing. God is always working through a people.
- v. 18–21 The Holy Spirit uses four imperatives to make application for Gentile Christians.
 - We must not put down Israel. We must not think ourselves better that Israel. We must fear God for what He has done through Israel.

Therefore consider the goodness and severity of God: on those who fell, severity; but toward you, goodness, if you continue in His goodness. Otherwise you also will be cut off.

- We must understand the severity and goodness of God in His dealings with people.
- The Holy Spirit warns those who are presumptuous to repent.
- The Holy Spirit exhorts those who are humble to continue in faithfulness.

Behold the proud, His soul is not upright in him; But the just shall live by his faith. Habakkuk 2:4

O the deep, deep love of Jesus!


