Intro:

READ WLC Q&A 184. Lawful = Biblical.

<u>Main Point of Text:</u> God turns a deaf ear to the prayer life of those who won't listen to the Law of the Lord for their living.

Sermon Point: Pray for Things Lawful.

Move 1: You are to pray "Thy will be done" in all things to glorify the God of all things. LC: "We are to pray for all things":

- "tending to the glory of God": WLC Q&A 1. Mt. 6:9-10: After this manner therefore pray ye: Our Father which art in heaven, <u>Hallowed be thy name</u>. <u>Thy kingdom come</u>. <u>Thy will be done</u> in earth, as it is in heaven. Closes For <u>thine is the kingdom</u>, and the power, <u>and the glory</u>, for ever. Amen. (vs. 13)
- "the welfare of the church":
 - o Ps. 51:18: Do good in thy good pleasure unto Zion: build thou the walls of Jerusalem.
 - o Ps. 122:6: *Pray for the peace of Jerusalem*: they shall prosper that love thee.
- "our own ... good": Mat. 7:11: If ye then, being evil, know how to give good gifts unto your children, how much more shall your Father which is in heaven give good things to them that <u>ask him</u>?
- "others good": Psa. 125:4: <u>Do good, O LORD, unto those that be good,</u> and to them that are upright in their hearts.

Move 2: You are never to pray for anything against God's revealed will, nor live against Him. LC: "but not for any thing that is unlawful [unbiblical]": 1 John 5:14: And this is the confidence that we have in him, that, if we ask any thing according to his will, he heareth us. Opposite also is true:

- Psalm 109:7: When he shall be judged, let him be condemned: and let his prayer become sin.
- Proverb 21:13, 17: Whoso stoppeth his ears at the cry of the poor, he also shall cry himself, but shall not be heard ... The sacrifice of the wicked is abomination: how much more, when he bringeth it with a wicked mind? So to their prayers.
- <u>Proverb 28:9</u>: The one that takes away his ear from hearing of the Law ["Torah": instruction, direction] also his prayer is abomination [to the Lord]. Must have the Giver to have His gifts.
- When you are an abomination to Him, so are your prayers: ... when ye spread forth your hands, <u>I</u> will hide mine eyes from you: yea, when ye make many prayers, <u>I will not hear:</u> your hands are full of blood. (Isa. 1:15) Psalm 66:18-20: If I regard iniquity in my heart, the Lord will not hear me: But verily God hath heard me; he hath attended to the voice of my prayer. Blessed be God, which hath not turned away my prayer, nor his mercy from me.
