 - C. Boldness from Obedience to the Almighty (4:19-20; 2 Tim 2:9)

2. What is your reaction to the claim that there is salvation in no other name—in Jesus' name alone?
3. Where does boldness to proclaim Jesus come from?
4. How would your life change if proclaiming Jesus were outlawed in the US? Would it change?
