Main Idea: God offers Himself to you, to be your Salvation and Provision, in Jesus Christ.

Introduction: Ark-departure logistics: a calendar of caution and procedure of prudence.

- 1. God remembered Noah: what our forgetting reminds us that God never forgets
- 2. Noah remembered the dove: a picture of the Redeemer in one whom He has redeemed
- 3. God spoke to Noah: the Redeemer who assures His redeemed
- 4. God speaks to us

Conclusion: The Lord Jesus is, Himself, the most glorious instance of how God displays Himself to us in this passage. Behold Him here. Behold Him throughout Scripture. Receive and rest upon Him alone for salvation as He reaches out His hand (so to speak) to take you into safety—to take you to Himself!
