Start Here: Christ; Romans 3:9-31; Colossians 2:6-23.

Today's Point: Jesus Christ brings sinners into God's Kingdom by taking the punishment for their sins, and granting them His righteousness before God.

Righteousness through Faith

- The purpose of the law was to reveal sin, taking away every excuse, and making all mankind accountable to God. It cannot save. Romans 3:19-20, 3:28, 1:20, 2:1; Galatians 3:19-22.
- First, Jesus took our place paying the price for sin. Romans 2:25, 6:23, 5:1-21; Genesis 2:16-17; Isaiah 53:4-5;

- Second, Jesus granted us the righteousness of God through faith in Jesus Christ. Romans 3:21-22; Matthew 17:5; Hebrews 4:15; John 17:4.
- He shows this with Abraham faith transacted into righteousness - a credit on the account - as far back as Genesis 15:6, 22:1-19. See Romans 4:1-25; Galatians 3:6; James 2:23.

A Triumph over Evil

- Apart from Jesus Christ, the world is under the influence of dark spiritual forces, Ephesians 2:1-3, 6:12; 2 Corinthians 4:4; 1 John 5:19.
- But in the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ, these are defeated and are merely awaiting sentencing, John 12:31; 1 John 4:4; Colossians 2:8-23; 1 Corinthians 2:6-8; Acts 2:24; Revelation 19:20, 20:10, 20:14-15, 21:8.

A Kingdom to Enjoy

- Our reconciliation to God in Jesus Christ re-establishes us in our garden mission and eventually into garden conditions. Genesis 1:26-28; Matthew 28:18-20; Revelation 21-22.
- And all the promises of God are shown true in the resurrection of Jesus Christ! Acts 17:31; Romans 1:4;
