Q4: How do associations differ from denominations?

The question is, where does authority reside?

There are so many different kinds of denominations, but usually authority resides within the denomination or presbytery.

Who owns the building? Who appoints (or removes) pastors, elders, and deacons? Who does church discipline? Who decides on doctrinal issues, or issues of practice?

Again, denominations or presbyteries differ greatly one from another, but the overarching principle is that the buck stops with them, and not with the local church.

Our view is that the buck stops with the local church, made up of elders, and deacons and members, with Christ as the head, and his word as the final authority.

"If he refuses to listen to them, tell it to the church. And if he refuses to listen even to the church, let him be to you as a Gentile and a tax collector." (Matthew 18:17, ESV)

"When you are assembled in the name of the Lord Jesus and my spirit is present, with the power of our Lord Jesus, you are to deliver this man to Satan for the destruction of the flesh, so that his spirit may be saved in the day of the Lord." (1 Corinthians 5:4–5, ESV)

This does not mean that local churches are to be purely independent though.
