 - F. The Book of Revelation
 - 1. The book of Revelation refers to Jesus as the Lamb 31 times (
 - 2. Revelation 5:6, 8, 12-13; 6:1, 7, 9, 16; 7:9-10, 14, 17; 8:1; 12:11; 13:8; 14:1, 4(x2), 10; 15:3; 17:4(x2); 19:7, 9; 21:9, 14, 22-23, 27; 22:1, 3
