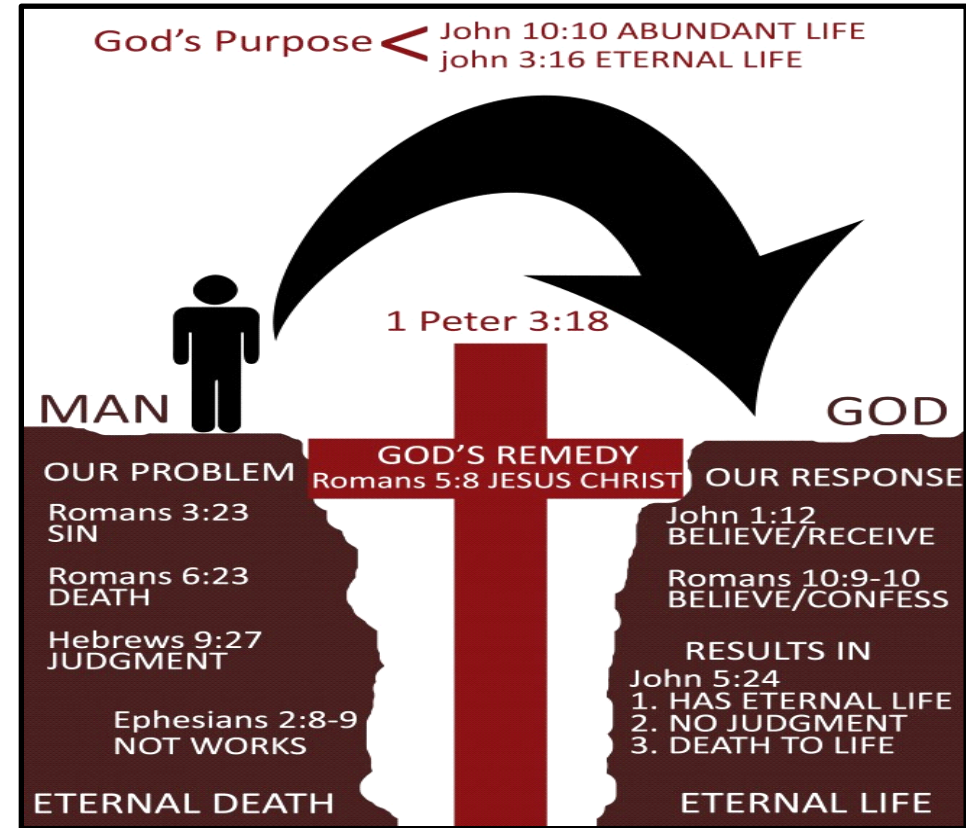

**David Was Crowned King according to the Word of the Lord**  
**2 Samuel 5:1–5**

David was anointed according to the word of the Lord - **1 Samuel 16:12**

Jonathan believed the word of the Lord - **1 Samuel 18:4; 20:15; 23:17**

Saul rejected the word of the Lord - **1 Samuel 13:14; 15:25–28; 24:17–22**

David was anointed king of Judah according to the word of the Lord - **2 Samuel 2:1–4a**

David was anointed king of Israel according to the word of the Lord - **1 Chronicles 11:1–3**

The people believed the word of the Lord - **1 Chronicles 12:1–40**

The men of the tribe of Issachar were given spiritual insight - **1 Chronicles 12:32**

- Issachar was a small tribe with little influence and clout.
- The men of Issachar had understanding of the times. Understanding comes from properly discerning facts along with relational, moral, and spiritual considerations.
- **Proverbs 1:2 To know wisdom and instruction, To perceive the words of understanding**
- **Proverbs 4:5 Get wisdom! Get understanding! Do not forget, nor turn away from the words of my mouth.**
- **Proverbs 9:10 The fear of the LORD is the beginning of wisdom, And the knowledge of the Holy One is understanding.**
- **Proverbs 3:5–6 Trust in the LORD with all your heart, And lean not on your own understanding; In all your ways acknowledge Him, And He shall direct your paths.**
- A right understanding includes an obligation to act.

We must have a right understanding of Christ - **Luke 12:54–56**

- **John 1:14 And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth.**
- **1 Thessalonians 2:13 For this reason we also thank God without ceasing, because when you received the word of God which you heard from us, you welcomed it not as the word of men, but as it is in truth, the word of God, which also effectively works in you who believe.**
- **Ephesians 1:15–23**
