The City of David 2 Samuel 5:6–16

David established Jerusalem as the capital and center of God's kingdom.

David conquered Jerusalem - 2 Samuel 5:6-8

- Jerusalem means city of peace.
- The first act of David as king of Israel was to make Jerusalem his capital city.
- Jerusalem was the ancient city of Salem where Abraham gave an offering to Melchizedek (Gen 14:14–24) and Mount Zion is the same Mount Moriah where Abraham offered Isaac to the Lord (Gen 22).
- God put the Jebusites under herem (curse) Deuteronomy 7:1–26
- King David was loyal and obedient to the Lord.
- The Jebusites mocked David (v. 6), so David made a mockery of the Jebusites.
- Joab led a force through the water shaft to defeat the Jebusites (1Ch 11:6).

The Lord blessed David in Jerusalem - 2 Samuel 5:9-16

- David dwelt in Jerusalem.
- Daved built up Jerusalem.
- David established Jerusalem as the capital of his kingdom Deuteronomy 12:11 then there will be the place where the LORD your God chooses to make His name abide. There you shall bring all that I command you: your burnt offerings, your sacrifices, your tithes, the heave offerings of your hand, and all your choice offerings which you vow to the LORD.

Jerusalem is the place of God's blessing for all people.

- Jerusalem is where God has chosen for His dwelling place Psalm 122; Psalm 132:13–14 For the LORD has chosen Zion; He has desired it for His dwelling place. This is My resting place forever; Here I will dwell, for I have desired it.
- Jerusalem will never be utterly destroyed Luke 19:41–44; 21:20–24;
 Zechariah 12:2–3, 8–10
- Jerusalem is where the Lord brings His salvation Zechariah 13:1; Luke 18:31– 32 Then He took the twelve aside and said to them, "Behold, we are going up to Jerusalem, and all things that are written by the prophets concerning the Son of Man will be accomplished."
- Jerusalem is where Christ will return and reign Zechariah 14:4–9

Only the holy people of God will enter Jerusalem - **Revelation 21:27 But there shall by** no means enter it anything that defiles, or causes an abomination or a lie, but only those who are written in the Lamb's Book of Life.
