- 2. Read **Acts 26:25**; **2 Corinthians 10:5**; and **1 Peter 3:15**. What concerns you most about the biblical command that you should be ready to respond to people's opposition to biblical truth and the gospel?
- 3. Read Romans 1:18-21; Luke 19:14 and John 3:19-20. How do these insights help you in your defense of the gospel as you consider the motivations for people denying the truth? Where might this direct more of the conversations you have with those who seek to evade what God's word says?
- 4. Read Romans 1:1-4; Isaiah 44:7-8 and 46:9-10. Why are the written prophecies of the Old Testament and the bodily resurrection of Christ in the New Testament so important for your confident defense of biblical Christianity?
- 5. Read **Hebrews 10:30-31**; **Romans 2:3-5** and **2 Corinthians 5:11 & 20**. How should these passages motivate you to do a whole lot more than just casually asking people to consider Christianity as a possible option?
