Two Are Better Than One

Eccl 4:7-12 Then I returned, and I saw vanity under the sun. There is one alone, and there is not a second; yea, he hath neither child nor brother: yet is there no end of all his labour; neither is his eye satisfied with riches; neither saith he, For whom do I labour, and bereave my soul of good? This is also vanity, yea, it is a sore travail. Two are better than one; because they have a good reward for their labour. For if they fall, the one will lift up his fellow: but woe to him that is alone when he falleth; for he hath not another to help him up. Again, if two lie together, then they have heat: but how can one be warm alone? And if one prevail against him, two shall withstand him; and a threefold cord is not quickly broken.

- I. To spend life alone is not the best way.
 - A. We are not talking here about those who are widowed or those who are not able to have children but about those who deliberately chose to be alone.
 - 1. Not marry
 - 2. Not have children
 - B. You have nothing to work for.

"For whom do I labour, and bereave my soul of good?" (v. 8)

- C. Life is meaningless when all it's labor and sacrifice is simply for self.
- D. There is no satisfaction in riches that you only desire so you can hoard them to yourself.
 - 1. There is no satisfaction in achievements when there is no one that it honors but yourself.
- E. Life has no meaning when you cannot give something to someone else.

"It is more blessed to give than to receive." (Acts 20:35)

- F. A life lived alone is vanity and sore travail.
 - 1. The meaning here is "a calamitous affair."
 - 2. It is a calamity to be alone and never have anyone who depends upon you.
 - 3. It is a calamity to be alone and never have anyone you can depend upon.
 - 4. A person who is alone is a sad thing we have all seen.

Gen 2:18 And the LORD God said, It is not good that the man should be alone; ...

II. Two are better than one.

- A. While a very selfish person may contend that he is happier alone he is in opposition to God with such thinking because two ARE BETTER than one.
- B. Some people isolate themselves alone because they have been hurt by someone.
 - 1. We may understand and sympathize with someone in this, but it is simply selfish and ungodly behavior to be that way.
- C. Whatever reasons you might give for maintaining your solitude and isolation it is contrary to the Word of God and to God's will.

III. Reasons why two are better than one:

- A. Because they have a good reward for their labor.
 - 1. This means they have a precious (or best) benefit.

- B. There is more pleasure and satisfaction from the labor because it is for the benefit of someone besides your self whom you love.
- C. It makes the labor more bearable it is a motivation when you would otherwise despair. ("Buy the baby a new pair of shoes.")
- D. You have help in trouble.

For if they fall, the one will lift up his fellow: but woe to him that is alone when he falleth; for he hath not another to help him up. (v. 10)

- 1. WHEN you fall ...not IF you fall; it is going to happen to you sooner or later.
- 2. When you are sick or hurt it is a great comfort to have someone to help.
- E. "Woe" unto him that is alone when he falls.
 - 1. There are times when you fall and cannot get up by yourself. What happens then?
- F. When it is cold you can keep each other warm.
 - 1. When you are both alone together and all the world is against you then there is still comfort.
 - 2. It is much easier to face rejection from everyone else if you have someone who is always with you.
- G. When an enemy comes there is more strength to withstand when there is someone with you and on your side.
 - 1. The threefold cord speaks of family.
- IV. The lesson is that we NEED others.
 - A. God made us that way.
 - B. God designed the creation so that all things work together not a bunch of solitary "lone wolves" doing their own thing.
 - C. A selfish person will be a lonely person and if you see a lonely person who is alone because they want to be, you can be pretty sure that they have been a selfish person.
