- -Is. 28:10 "For precept must be upon precept, precept upon precept; line upon line, line upon line; here a little, and there a little:"

Precepts to understand for a foundation:

-4 fold separation of Jesus at his death:

-Jesus is our high priest (Heb 9:11-12), the high priest would first make an atonement for his own sins, then for the sins of the people on the day of atonement. (Lev. 16:1-15)

- Jesus is the BRANCH pictured in Joshua the high priest.

Observations & possible timeline:

- -John 20:11-17 "Touch me not; for I am not yet ascended to my Father"
- 1. Jesus' soul is the brand plucked out of the fire. His soul comes out of the fires of hell and stands before God in our filthy garments (Zech. 3:1-8) -Consecrated as our high priest.
- 2. Soul & spirit of life united and given back to the Holy One of God (the body of Jesus Christ) Then comes the bodily resurrection.
- 3. Jesus appears before Mary Magdalene. Tells her "Touch me not; for I am not yet ascended to my Father:" Cannot be touched (Hag.2:12&13) has yet to ascend to perform our high priestly duty (Hebrews 9:12)
- 4. Ascends to the father. Enters once behind the vail- to obtain eternal redemption for us. (Hebrews 9:12&24)
 - 5. **Observation**: John 20:26 "After 8 days..." Leviticus 8:31-9:1
