

Confession of Faith

Westminster Confession of Faith Chapter 8, Paragraphs 6, 8

Although the work of redemption was not actually wrought by Christ till after His incarnation, yet the virtue, efficacy, and benefits thereof were communicated unto the elect, in all ages successively from the beginning of the world, in and by those promises, types, and sacrifices, wherein He was revealed, and signified to be the seed of the woman which should bruise the serpent's head; and the Lamb slain from the beginning of the world; being yesterday and today the same, and forever.

To all those for whom Christ hath purchased redemption, He doth certainly and effectually apply and communicate the same; making intercession for them, and revealing unto them, in and by the Word, the mysteries of salvation; effectually persuading them by His Spirit to believe and obey, and governing their hearts by His Word and Spirit; overcoming all their enemies by His almighty power and wisdom, in such manner, and ways, as are most consonant to His wonderful and unsearchable dispensation.

Corporate Confession of Sin

Assurance of Pardon

Psalm 32:3-5 (LSB)

When I kept silent about my sin, my bones wasted away through my groaning all day long. For day and night Your hand was heavy upon me; My vitality was drained away as with the heat of summer. I acknowledged my sin to You, and my iniquity I did not cover up; I said, "I will confess my transgressions to Yahweh;" and You forgave the iniquity of my sin.

Job 42 (LSB)

Then Job answered Yahweh and said, "I know that You can do all things, and that no purpose of Yours can be thwarted. 'Who is this that hides counsel without knowledge?' Therefore I have declared that which I did not understand, things too marvelous for me, which I did not know.

'Hear, now, and I will speak; I will ask You, and You make me know.' I have heard of You by the hearing of the ear; But now my eye sees You; therefore I reject myself, and I repent in dust and ashes."

Now it happened after Yahweh had spoken these words to Job, that Yahweh said to Eliphaz the Temanite, "My anger burns against you and against your two friends because you have not spoken of Me what is right as My servant Job has. So now, take for yourselves seven bulls and seven rams, and go to My servant Job, and offer up a burnt offering for yourselves, and My servant Job will pray for you. For I will accept him so that I may not do with you according to your folly, because you have not spoken of Me what is right, as My servant Job has." So Eliphaz the Temanite and Bildad the Shuhite and Zophar the Naamathite went and did as Yahweh told them; and Yahweh accepted Job.

And Yahweh restored the fortunes of Job when he prayed for his friends, and Yahweh increased all that Job had twofold. Then all his brothers and all his sisters and all who had known him before came to him, and they ate bread with him in his house; and they consoled him and comforted him for all the calamity that Yahweh had brought on him. And each one gave him one qesitah, and each a ring of gold. And Yahweh blessed the latter days of Job more than his beginning; and he had 14,000 sheep and 6,000 camels and 1.000 pairs of oxen and 1,000 female donkeys. He also had seven sons and three duaghters. And he named the first Jemimah and the second Keziah and the third Keren-happuch. Now in all the land no women were found so beautiful as Job's daughters; and their father gave them inheritance among their brothers. And after this, Job lived 140 years and was his sons and his grandsons, four generations. Then Job died, an old man and full of days.
