

David's Kindness to Mephibosheth 2 Samuel 9:1–13

v. 1–4a - David sought for a descendant of Saul.

- David sought to keep his covenant with Jonathan (1Sa 18:3; 20:15).
- Ziba appeared to want to serve David and to help Mephibosheth.
- David wanted to show God's lovingkindness and mercy (hesed) to a descendant of Saul just as God had showed him 2 Samuel 7:15; Psalm 25:6–7 Remember, O LORD, Your tender mercies and Your lovingkindnesses, For they are from of old. Do not remember the sins of my youth, nor my transgressions; According to Your mercy remember me, For Your goodness' sake, O LORD.

v. 4b-8 - David found Mephibosheth.

- Mephibosheth was crippled and unable to provide for himself 2 Samuel 4:4
- Mephibosheth was in exile on the other side of the Jordan River in a place where there
 is no pasture.
- His given name was probably Merib-Baal (1Ch 8:34) meaning Baal Contends. His name is changed to Mephibosheth meaning from the mouth of shamefulness.
- David called him by name, but Mephibosheth answered as a subordinate.
- David assured Mephibosheth that he would not destroy him for Saul's sake but would show him mercy for Jonathan's sake.
- Mephibosheth humbled himself as unworthy and undeserving of David's lovingkindness, mercy, and grace.

v. 9–13 - David blessed Mephibosheth.

- David restored to Mephibosheth all that Saul had lost.
- David gave Mephibosheth a place at his table for provision and fellowship.
- David provided Mephibosheth a permanent home in Jerusalem.

David's kindness to Mephibosheth typifies Christ's kindness to sinners.

- It is Christ who seeks the sinner Luke 19:10 for the Son of Man has come to seek and to save that which was lost."
- It is Christ who saves a crippled sinner from a barren unproductive life 2 Corinthians
 5:17 Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new.
- It is Christ who brings unworthy and undeserving sinners into fellowship with Himself Revelation 3:20 Behold, I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears My voice and opens
 the door, I will come in to him and dine with him, and he with Me.
- It is Christ who is faithful to honor His covenant relationship with us.

But God, who is rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us, even when we were dead in trespasses, made us alive together with Christ (by grace you have been saved), and raised us up together, and made us sit together in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus, that in the ages to come He might show the exceeding riches of His grace in His kindness toward us in Christ Jesus.
