LUKE 6:27-36

**1 John 3:17** » whoever has the world's goods, and beholds his brother in need and closes his heart against him, how does the love of God abide in him?

**Matthew 25:41-42** » Depart from Me, accursed ones, into the eternal fire which has been prepared for the devil and his angels; <sup>42</sup> for I was hungry, and you gave Me nothing to eat; I was thirsty, and you gave Me nothing to drink; <sup>43</sup> I was a stranger, and you did not invite Me in; naked, and you did not clothe Me; sick, and in prison, and you did not visit Me.'

**Galatians 6:10** » while we have opportunity, let us do good to all men, and especially to those who are of the household of the faith.

**1 Thessalonians 5:14** ~ encourage the faint-hearted, help the weak, be patient with everyone

**Matthew 5:7** » Blessed are the merciful, for they shall receive mercy.

**James 2:13** » judgment will be merciless to one who has shown no mercy

**Luke 6:35-36**

**Ephesians 2:3-5** » we too all formerly lived in the lusts of our flesh, indulging the desires of the flesh and of the mind, and were by nature children of wrath, even as the rest. 4 But God, being rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us, 5 even when we were dead in our transgressions, made us alive together with Christ

**Psalm 103:8-14** » The Lord is compassionate and gracious, Slow to anger and abounding in lovingkindness. <sup>9</sup> He will not always strive with us; Nor will He keep His anger forever. <sup>10</sup> He has not dealt with us according to our sins, nor rewarded us according to our iniquities. <sup>11</sup> For as high as the heavens are above the earth, so great is His lovingkindness toward those who fear Him. <sup>12</sup> As far as the east is from the west, so far has He removed our transgressions from us. <sup>13</sup> Just as a father has compassion on his children, So the Lord has compassion on those who fear Him. <sup>14</sup> For He Himself knows our frame; He is mindful that we are but dust.
