Sermon Outline

Receiving the Word with Eagerness

Acts 17:10-15

Introduction: The Joy of Fulfilled Expectations

Exposition: Paul and Silas in Berea

1. The mission team preaches in Berean synagogue. (v10)
2. The Berean Jews receive and believe the word. (v11-12)
3. The Thessalonian Jews come to Berea to agitate the gospel work. (v13)
4. Paul goes to Athens to wait for the team. (v14-15)

Application: Receiving the Word as the Bereans Did Brings Glory to God!

The principle: a church community eagerly receiving the truth of God's word as they discover Christ in all the scriptures!

1. Receive the Word with Eagerness.
2. Receive the Word *within* the Corporate Gatherings.
3. Discover Christ in the Word.
4. Search the Word Regularly.
5. Believe the Word Joyfully.
