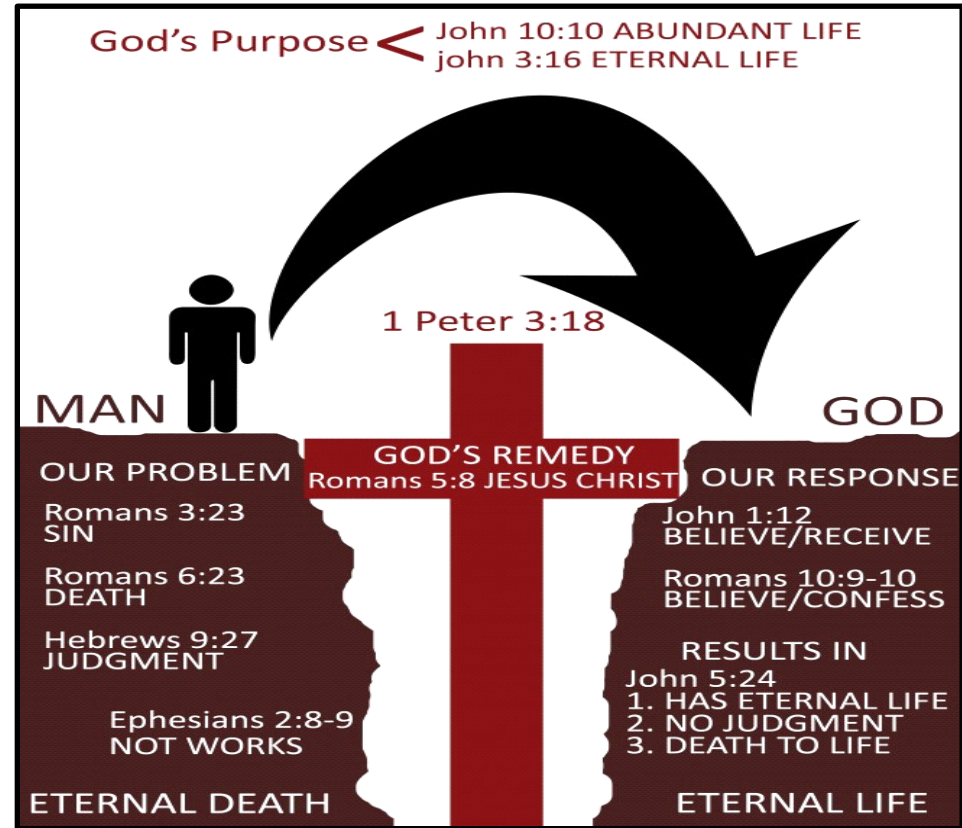

David at the Height of His Power
2 Samuel 8 & 10 & 11:1

The Lord gave David the victory and blessing.

8:1–6 - David defeated the enemies of Israel.

- The Lord saved David wherever he went - **Deuteronomy 20:4 for the LORD your God is He who goes with you, to fight for you against your enemies, to save you.**

8:7–14 - David was blessed with great prosperity.

- The Lord saved David wherever he went - **Psalm 20:6–7 Now I know that the LORD saves His anointed; He will answer him from His holy heaven With the saving strength of His right hand. Some trust in chariots, and some in horses; But we will remember the name of the LORD our God.**

8:18–18 - David successfully reigned over all Israel.

9:1–13 - David showed goodness to Mephibosheth, who received him.

10:1–5 - David's showed goodness to Hanun, who rejected him.

10:6–14 - David sent his best soldiers to defeat Ammon.

10:15–19 - David defeated the Syrians.

11:1 - David fell into sin at the height of his life.

- David was not where he should have been - **2 Timothy 2:3 You therefore must endure hardship as a good soldier of Jesus Christ.**
- David took his position for granted - **1 Corinthians 10:12–13 Therefore let him who thinks he stands take heed lest he fall. No temptation has overtaken you except such as is common to man; but God is faithful, who will not allow you to be tempted beyond what you are able, but with the temptation will also make the way of escape, that you may be able to bear it.**
- David overlooked the spiritual danger - **Mark 14:38 Watch and pray, lest you enter into temptation. The spirit indeed is willing, but the flesh is weak.**

David lost the victory and blessing because he was defeated by personal sin.
