- I. The Spirit Helps Us In Our Weakness (26-27)
  - A. We are weak because we still abide in this flesh and make war with it.
  - B. We do not even know how to pray – the cry of the warring Christian is too deep for words
  - C. Yet Christ, our intercessor, knows the mind of the Spirit – and He does so according to the will of the Father
- II. God's Work On Our Behalf In Jesus (28-30)
  - A. What good does God bring together?
  - B. God does this for those that He loves, those called according to His purpose
  - C. And what is the purpose of God's calling? To be made like Jesus
  - D. How is this work made sure? Because it is made in the eternal mind and work of God
  - E. Why grammar matters
- III. The Triune God Gives Us Victory Over Sin (31-39)
  - A. So, how do these truths make the gospel victorious now? Because nothing can diminish the work, power, grace, glory, and greatness of God, in Christ, through the Spirit, in our lives.
  - B. Who can condemn you in your sin now?
  - C. Who can separate us from the love of Christ?
  - D. We are more than conquerors! Why? Because the Triune God is our victor
