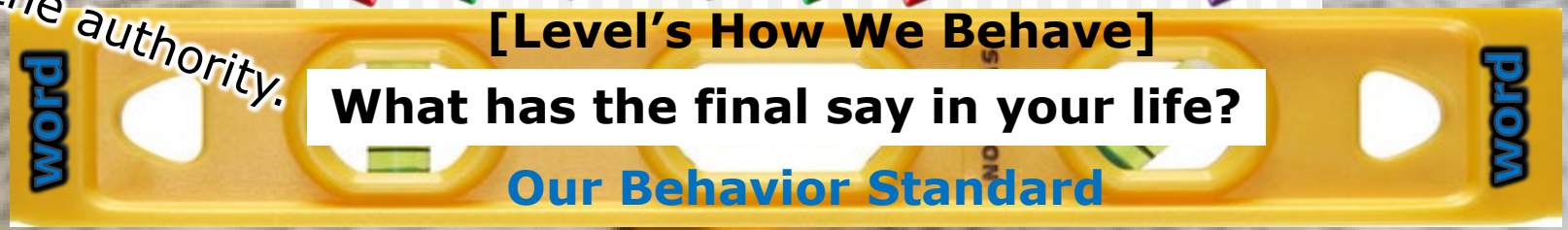

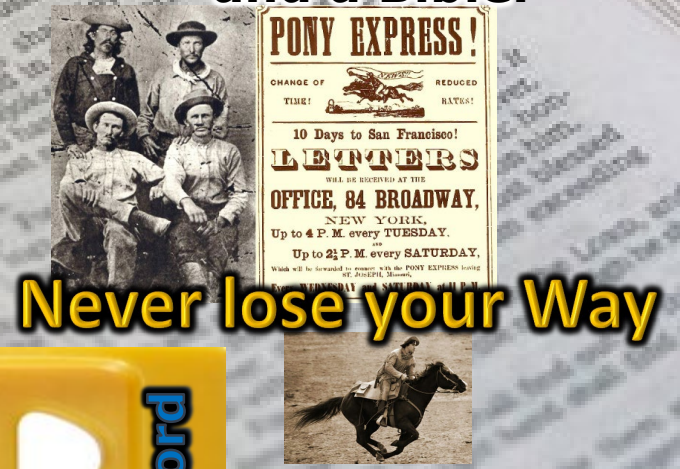

# What has the final say in your life?

**No life - Not a Christian –**

Spiritually dead. Insensitive to God's presence & purpose

**New Life - New Christian –**

Not fully grown but the potential like a seed is all there.

**Lots of Life - Growing Christian –**

He is sensitive & alert to the special life that is flowing through them. Evidences of life.

**Doesn't nurture life - Backsliding Christian –**

They have no fruit and living contrary with themselves.

**Ignores life - Fallen away –**

They ignore the needs of their spiritual life and have left the Christian faith.

**Abundant Life - Mature Christian -**

Someone who has consistently grown over a number of years. The growth is steady & the fruit is consistent

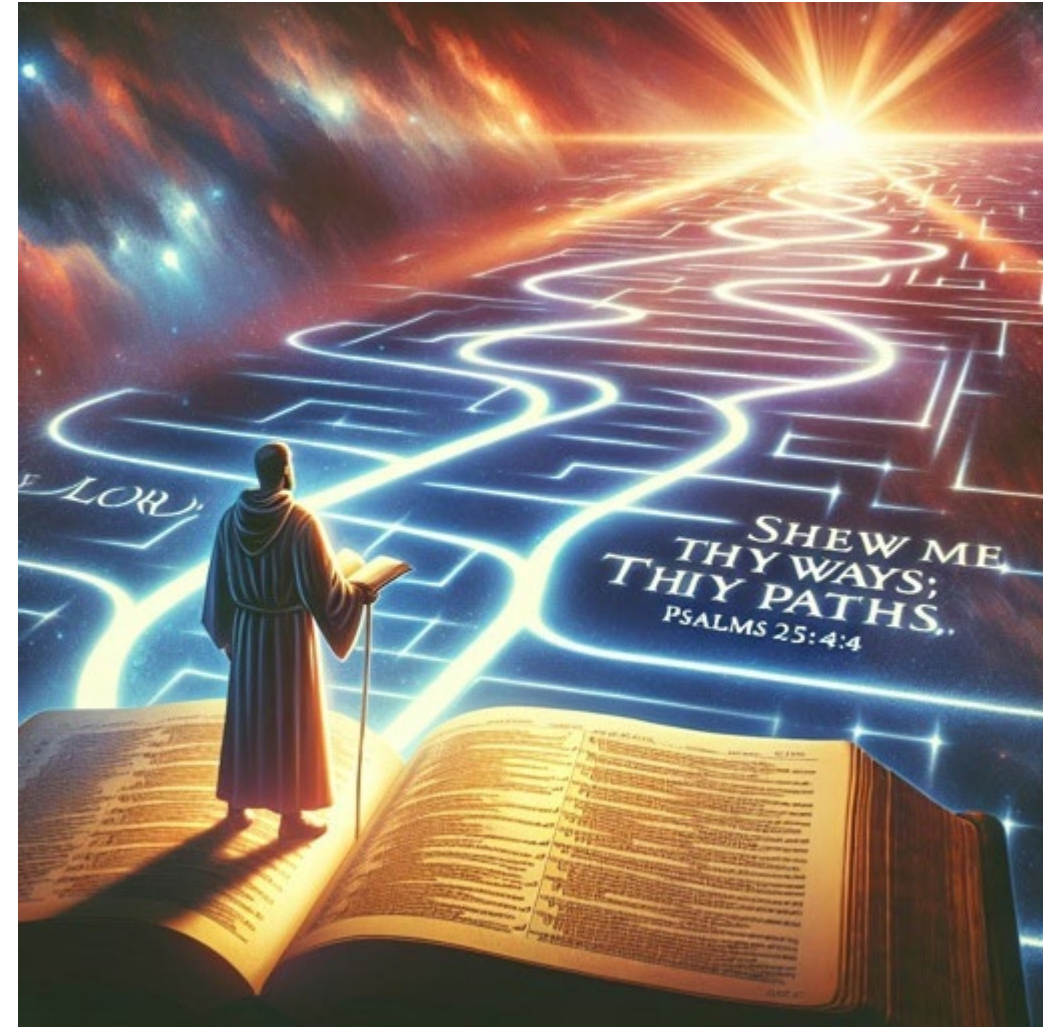

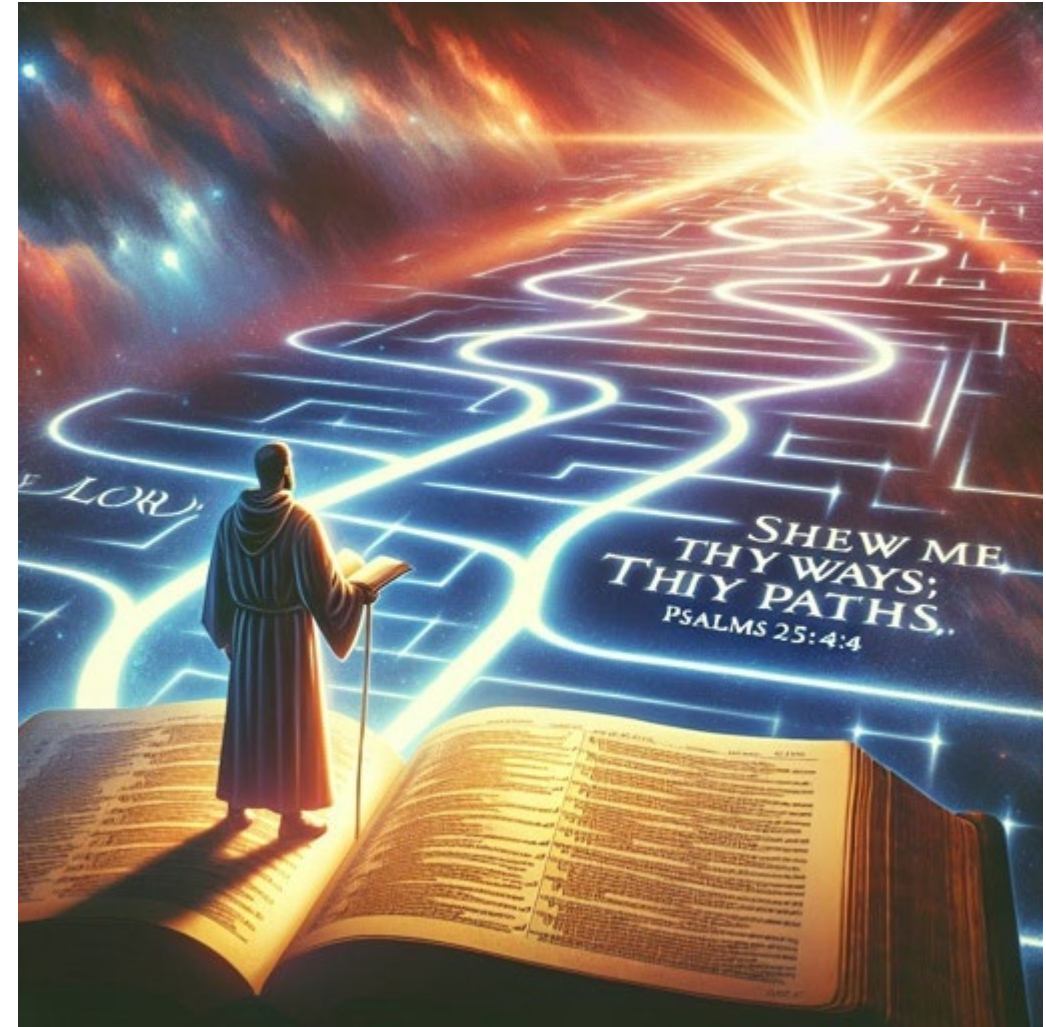

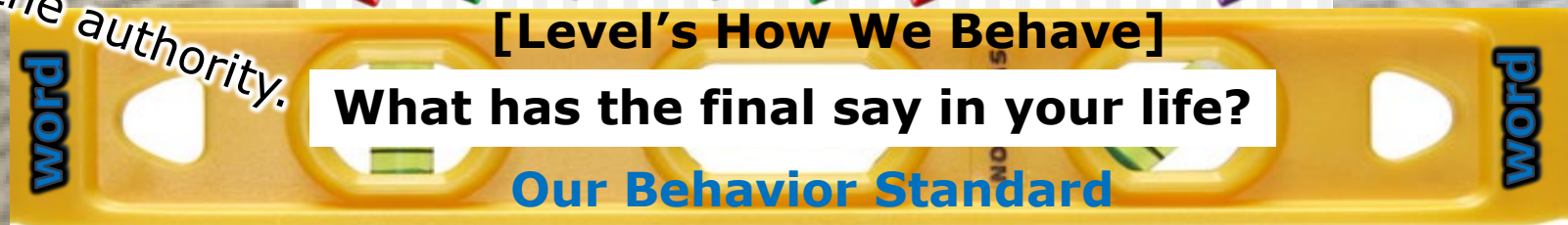
