Lot (Genesis 19)

Found in Sodom
At evening
Sat in the gates of the city
Two visitors- the Lord is missing
Rose up to meet them
Bowed himself to the ground
Calls himself "thy servant"
Asks them to stay (overnight)
They can wash their own feet
They decline/ He pleads greatly
His wife is not mentioned

Abraham (Genesis 18)

Found in the plains of Mamre
In the heat of the day
Sat in his tent door
Three visitors – the Lord included
Ran to meet them
Bowed himself to the ground
Calls himself "thy servant"
Asks them to stay
Offers to wash their feet
They accept
Sarah is there to help

He does not lead/ doesn't ask
Anyone to help/ prepares feast by himself
Doesn't mention serving or waiting
They have an interruption

He leads his home by giving instructions
He serves and waits upon them
They have a conversation – (fellowship)
