I. His goodness is His glory in restoring the covenant (vv. 1-4).

“Cut for yourself two tablets of stone like the first”

“He rose early in the morning & went up on Mount Sinai ... took in his hand two tablets”

II. His goodness is His glory in abounding covenant faithfulness (vv. 5-7).

“The LORD descended in the cloud”

“God merciful & gracious, slow to anger, and abounding in steadfast love & faithfulness”

“keeping steadfast love for thousands, forgiving iniquity, and transgression and sin”

“by no means clear the guilty, visiting the iniquity ... to the third and fourth generation”
