

The Glory of God In Grace
Isaiah 29:15-24

- I. Trying To Hide From God (15-16)
 - A. Woe – mourning an impending death
 - B. To whom?
 - 1. Those who conceal sin (of all kinds)
 - 2. Who deny God by their lifestyle (Psalm 10 & 14)
 - C. Notice the “lack of community”
 - 1. It may be a “group” that lives this way
 - 2. But they are hiding and living alone in the darkness
- II. Hope For The Hopeless (17-21)
 - A. A day of blessing and deliverance is coming
 - B. Notice the metaphors
 - 1. Dry, desert place that blooms with fruit and trees
 - 2. The deaf hear
 - 3. The blind see
 - 4. The afflicted and needy become glad and rejoice
 - C. These are all things that cannot be done by the recipient for themselves – God must do this work
 - D. How is this accomplished?
 - 1. The ruthless, evildoer, and misuser of the tongue
 - 2. These will be “ended” and “cut-off”
- III. The Glory of God In Grace (22-24)
 - A. Redeeming Abraham and Jacob
 - 1. Issue of seed
 - 2. Issue of community

- B. His children, the work of God’s hand
- C. Sanctifying God’s name
 - 1. Setting Him apart
 - 2. Acknowledging God’s rightful place as king
- D. The corrective power of grace
 - 1. Faulty thinking is corrected
 - 2. Faulty living is corrected
