#### What Did We See Last Time?


- Jesus said that He will send the angels to gather His people from earth and heaven.

Mark 14:1-2

14<sup>:1</sup> Now the Passover and Unleavened Bread were two days away; and the chief priests and the scribes were seeking how to seize Him by stealth and kill Him;

<sup>2</sup> for they were saying,

"Not during the festival, otherwise there might be a riot of the people."

14<sup>:3</sup> While He was in Bethany at the home of Simon the leper, and reclining at the table, there came a woman with an alabaster vial of very costly perfume of pure nard; and she broke the vial and poured it over His head.

<sup>4</sup>But some were indignantly remarking to one another,

"Why has this perfume been wasted?

<sup>5</sup> For this perfume might have been sold for over three hundred denarii, and the money given to the poor."

And they were scolding her.

"Let her alone; why do you bother her? She has done a good deed to Me. <sup>7</sup> For you always have the poor with you, and whenever you wish you can do good to them; but you do not always have Me.
