

God's Call and His Assurance

(Exodus chapter 6:9-13; 28-7:7)

(The Genealogy of Moses and Aaron – Exodus 6:14-27 - will be picked up in our next text)

Introduction: When does a full commitment to God's call take place in our lives?

1. vs 6:9-13; 28-30 Moses complains, but God calls

Moses complains

vs 12; 30 "But Moses said to the LORD, "Behold, the people of Israel have not listened to me. How then shall Pharaoh listen to me, for I am of uncircumcised lips?"

God calls

Vs 11 13, 29 Go and speak! Tell Pharaoh all I will tell you!

2. Ch 7 vs 1-5 God's Assurance to Moses

v 1 You shall be as God to Pharaoh and Aaron shall be your prophet

vs 2-3 Pharaoh's heart shall be hardened by God's sovereign hand!

v 4 God's judgement upon Egypt, "I will lay my hand upon Egypt with great acts of judgment!"

v 5 The Egyptian's shall know that that "I am the LORD"

3. vs 6-7 Moses and Aaron follow the LORD'S call

vs 6 – 7 Moses and Aaron heed the call of God afresh

God's call, His assurance to Moses that Pharaoh and Egypt will be judged.

Moses and Aaron heed the call of God
