## Fishers or Men (Luke 5: 1-11)

- Jesus taught, preached and healed (Matt 9:35-10:1)
  - 1. Scattered Sheep without a shepherd (35,36)
  - 2. Pray the Lord of the harvest send harvesters (37-10:1)
- Similar picture of needy souls gathered around Jesus.
- Jesus calls the disciples to be fishers of men.

# I. The Great Need (5:1-3)

- A. The multitudes pressing about Jesus. 5: 1-3
- B. The real and desperate need: "to hear the word of God."
- C. Peter's pragmatism an unbelief 5:4-5

## II. The Miracle of the Great Catch (5:6-7)

- A. the power of Jesus the Messiah
- B. Abundance contrast with impotency of men.

#### III. Fishers of Men (5: 8-11)

- A. Peter's humility and worship (v.8)
  - a. Ob: Peter saw Jesus for He is.
  - b. Ob. He saw himself for he was.
- B. Jesus Commissions the Disciples (v.9)
  - a. Ob. Comfort: "Do not be afraid."
  - b. Ob. Jesus commission: "you'll catch men."
- C. They forsook all and followed Him (v.11)
  - a. Obs. Immediate obedience: "brought their boats ashore."
  - b. Obs. cost you everything: "forsook all and followed Him."

#### The Son of Man Lifted Up (John 3:14.15)

- Nicodemus seeks out Jesus at night.
- Jesus: "unless a man is born again, not enter the kingdom of God."
- Nicodemus: How can these things be?
- Jesus: "man from heaven takes us to heaven." How?

#### I. The Son of Man Must Be Lifted Up (3:14)

"And as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness."

- A. Why is Moses lifting up the serpent in the desert is key to eternal life? Numb 21: 4-8 "rebellion, sin, curse, healing."
- B. Why did God choose to send serpents to afflict the Israelites? Sin and rebellion (Gen 3: 4)
- C. Why did Moses put a bronze serpent on a pole and lift it up?

  Serpent: a symbol of the curse became God's remedy.
- D. The Son of Man is the substance of that imagery.

"Even so the Son, must the Son of Man be lifted up."

2 Cor 5: 21; Deut 21: 22, 23; Jhn 8:28; 12:31-33

#### II. If You Believe This, You Will not Perish (3:15)

"Whoever believes in Him should not perish but have eternal life."

- A. We are saved and enter heaven by faith alone (John 6: 40)
- B. We are saved and enter heaven by faith in Christ alone.
