Q. 180. What is it to pray in the Name of Christ?

Answer

To pray in the Name of Christ is, in obedience to His command, and in confidence on His promises, to ask mercy for His sake; not by bare mentioning of His Name, but by drawing our encouragement to pray, and our boldness, strength, and hope of acceptance in prayer, from Christ and His mediation.

Q. 181. Why are we to pray in the name of Christ?

Answer

The sinfulness of man, and his distance from God by reason thereof, being so great, as that we can have no access into God's presence without a mediator; and there being none in heaven or earth appointed to, or fit for, that glorious work but Christ alone, we are to pray in no other name but His only.
