He also watches over me in such a way6 that not a hair can fall from my head without the will of my Father in heaven; 7 in fact, all things must work together for my salvation.8 Because I belong to Him, Christ by His Holy Spirit assures me of eternal life9 and makes me wholeheartedly willing and ready from now on to live for Him.10

Q2. What must you know to live and die in the joy of this comfort?

A. Three things: first, how great my sin and misery are;1 second, how I am set free from all my sins and misery;2 third, how I am to thank God for such deliverance.3
