CULTIVATING THE SPIRIT'S FRUIT: JOY

"Joy" was a popular theme at the recent Democratic Convention. A couple of speakers even quoted the Bible, "joy will come in the morning." But as one newspaper editorial noted, "this message...is not only naïve, it is completely out of touch with the reality most Americans face today." The Bible promises fullness of joy in God's presence. The second aspect of the Spirit's fruit listed in Galatians 5:22 is "joy."
