  - A. The evidence of it

    - 2. To be the model and example of what restored humanity had to be; perfect faith and obedience

    - 4. To taste of suffering and death for all humans that He would have complete knowledge of us
    - 5. To be the perfect sacrifice for redemption; the substitute sacrifice
    - 6. To be the ruler of all creation as originally intended for humanity
    - 7. To be the human of the lineage of David who would sit on the throne of the eternal kingdom

    - 2. The One chosen to be the Son of God and rule
