## THE TRUMP CARD | ECCLESIASTES 2:12-26

**Context:** The Teacher reflected on wisdom earlier in the book (1:12-18) and now returns to that topic, adding something very important to the equation: the "trump card" of death.

- 12-14 Basic truth: wisdom is better than folly.
- 14b-16 Two unavoidable realities:
- 17-25 Tension: Emotions (17-23) vs. Convictions (24-26)



## How should we think about these realities?

- 1. Acknowledge emotions but rest on \_\_\_\_\_\_.
- 2. Don't stifle or deny questions, but put them \_\_\_\_\_\_.
- 3. Enjoy God's gifts in the way He intends, but don't .
- 4. Don't deny the apparent futility of life, but know that with God \_\_\_\_\_
